AIR GREENLAND 2025: ENHANCED AIR TRANSPORT FROM NUUK

Air Greenland's 2025 schedule boosts transport opportunities between Nuuk and international destinations. With narrowbody aircraft operating from mid-March to early November, flexible morning and evening flights enhance connections to key locations.

Key routes include:

- Monday & Thursday: Late northbound flights via Kangerlussuaq to Copenhagen.
- Tuesday & Friday: Southbound routes from Nuuk to Copenhagen.
- Friday: Direct round-trip flights.
- Sunday: Northbound service to Nuuk.
- Monday: Southbound flights to Copenhagen.

This schedule ensures faster, reliable transportation between Greenland and global markets.

- Monday & Thursday Departures: Aalborg to Nuuk
- Direct flights from Aalborg to Nuuk every Monday and
 Thursday, from June 12 to September 1, will efficiently connect
 Northern Jutland with Greenland's capital, facilitating smooth
 transit between these key hubs.
- Thursday Route: Billund to Nuuk via Keflavik, direct return to Billund
- On Thursdays, travels from Billund to Nuuk with a stop in Keflavik. The return flight from Nuuk to Billund is direct, ensuring swift and efficient service.



Highlights from 2025 Flight Schedule:

New routes strengthen connections between Denmark, Greenland, Iceland – and Canada

Air Greenland is introducing important new and resumed routes that enhance connections between Denmark, Greenland, Iceland, and Canada, offering greater flexibility for both business and leisure travelers:

New Tuesday Route: Southbound Connection from Nuuk to Billund via Keflavik

The southbound flight will include a stopover in Keflavik, Iceland, providing an additional link between Greenland and Iceland before continuing to Billund. This service offers a seamless travel experience between Greenland, Iceland, and Denmark, making it easier and more appealing for both business and leisure travelers to journey between these key destinations.


Thursday Route: Northbound Flight from Billund to Nuuk via Keflavik

On Thursdays, the northbound flight from Billund to Nuuk will also include a stopover in Keflavik, Iceland, ensuring an optimal connection between these destinations. The southbound leg of the journey features a direct flight from Nuuk to Billund, guaranteeing a quick and efficient return trip.


Nuuk-Iqaluit Route Returns in 2025

From April 2 to October 28, 2025, Air Greenland's seasonal route between Nuuk and Iqaluit will return with weekly departures every Wednesday at 2:55 PM. This route provides a direct connection between Greenland and Canada, supporting both passenger and cargo travel while strengthening collaboration and ties within the Arctic.

As Greenland's national airline, Air Greenland continues to play a vital role in connecting Greenland with the rest of the world. These new routes support the airline's mission to strengthen connections to international markets and promote travel, trade, and cultural exchange, while also making Greenland more accessible.







Domestic flights - Hub and spoke

Connecting domestic and international routes (From November 28, 2024)

Air Greenland's 2025 domestic cargo operations are centered around a hub-and-spoke network, connecting key hubs in Nuuk and Ilulissat with major domestic airports daily. This new structure enhances same-day cargo connections across Northern, Central, Southern, and Eastern Greenland, and aligns domestic routes with international Atlantic flights.

Nuuk Hub:

With six Dash aircraft based in Nuuk, flights will depart in the morning to key domestic locations, returning by late morning to connect with international or other Greenlandic routes.

Ilulissat Hub:

Two Dash aircraft stationed in Ilulissat will service northern Greenland, ensuring timely cargo delivery and facilitating onward connections to Nuuk, international destinations, and other domestic regions.

This streamlined network improves the opportunities of cargo transport across Greenland, linking key regions and international markets.

Domestic flights - Hub and spoke

Connecting domestic and international routes (From November 28, 2024)

South Greenland (Qaqortoq/Narsaq/Nanortalik):

South Greenland will experience a major increase in weekly flights, connecting to North, Central, and East Greenland, with same-day links to the Atlantic route via Nuuk. A direct route between Narsarsuaq and Copenhagen will further enhance cargo transport, with up to five weekly flights increasing to 10 by summer 2025.

Central Greenland (Paamiut):

Flights to Paamiut will remain unchanged but will now route through Nuuk, allowing for better same-day connections to international and East Greenland routes.

Central Greenland (Maniitsoq):

While Maniitsoq will see a slight reduction in weekly flights, new sameday connections to East and South Greenland will improve logistics efficiency.

Central Greenland (Sisimiut):

Sisimiut will maintain 16 weekly departures, with an additional Saturday flight added to ensure smoother same-day connections to North and East Greenland, as well as the Atlantic route.

Central Greenland (Kangerlussuaq):

Northbound flights from Copenhagen to Nuuk, via Kangerlussuaq, will operate on Mondays and Thursdays. Southbound flights, also via Kangerlussuaq, are available on Tuesdays and Fridays, maintaining a robust connection for cargo flows.

North Greenland

(Aasiaat/Ilulissat/Qaarsut-Uummannaq/Upernavik):

The number of flights to North Greenland remains unchanged, but all flights will now connect through Ilulissat and Nuuk, providing same-day access to international routes.

North Greenland (Qaanaaq):

Flights to Qaanaaq remain steady, with one flight per week in winter and two weekly flights in summer.

East Greenland (Kulusuk):

From November 28, 2024, Kulusuk will benefit from improved sameday connections to both the domestic network and international Atlantic routes. With up to three weekly flights, this enhanced connectivity will support increased cargo traffic to East Greenland, including potential growth in tourism logistics.

This expanded network strengthens Air Greenland's ability to meet Greenland's demands, ensuring efficient connections to international markets and remote regions.
